The Debden Pentecostal Church has a goal to worship God and communicate God's love to the people of Debden and beyond.

Worship Services

Our main worship service is on Sunday morning and we have one evening service on the 3rd Sunday of each month which often attracts people from further afield. We still don't have a minister and continue to rely on a range of visiting speakers. We warmly welcome anyone to attend our services and advertise special speakers of interest in the Village Pump.

Weekly Coffee Mornings

The free coffee mornings are held each Wednesday and these have been well attended by quite a number from the village. This has been running for many years now and offers a friendly welcome and opportunity to meet others from around the village.

The "drugs run" continues every fortnight, a volunteer drops prescriptions in from Thaxted Surgery for those who have difficulty getting over there to collect them.

Joint activities with St Mary's Debden

We again joined forces with St Mary's on Good Friday for a March of Witness, starting at the parish church and ending up at the Pentecostal Church for hot cross buns.

Mission

We keep in close contact with a number of missions but particularly with two missionaries in the Democratic Republic of Congo. The situation out there is dire with violent robberies and assaults commonplace, the resurgence of cannibalism and the new outbreak of Ebola in the east of the country. We aim to support this valuable aid/mission work as best we can. Life out in Congo is a very bleak contrast from the peaceful setting of Debden.
